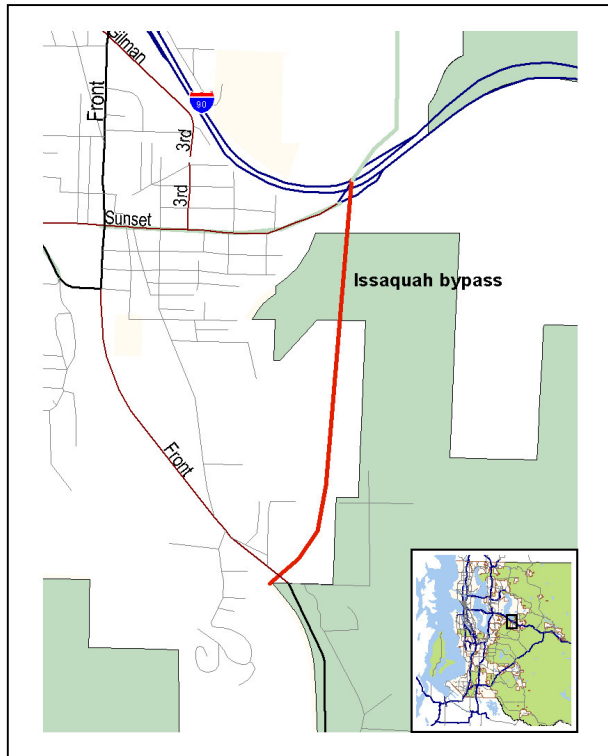
SE Issaquah Bypass from Front Street S. to I-90 (Issaquah)

Project Description

Lead Agency: Issaquah

The project is for construction of a new bypass arterial on the eastern edge of the City of Issaquah. The proposed 1.5 mile roadway would provide a new connection to Interstate 90 at the Sunset Interchange and extend south to Issaquah-Hobart Road near the city limits.

What New Funding Will Achieve

The bypass will reduce congestion in Issaquah's central business district and city streets by diverting regional traffic around the city's eastern edge and provide a third access point to Interstate 90. Travel time from the city limits to I-90 will take approximately 3 minutes. The project will also address City of Issaquah concurrency needs.
